The cache in Safari is located in your Library. . You can remove it from there but if you want it to NOT show up again you can delete it from the folder list. . . Deleting it from the Finder is the best option. Ive finally tried something, I deleted the cache from the Library and from the Safari preferences but I still see the message every time I login to the site, i've also tried deleting the folder from my Mac that contains the messages but that didn't work, there must be some settings somewhere but i can't find it.
